Youth Sponsorship is also available.

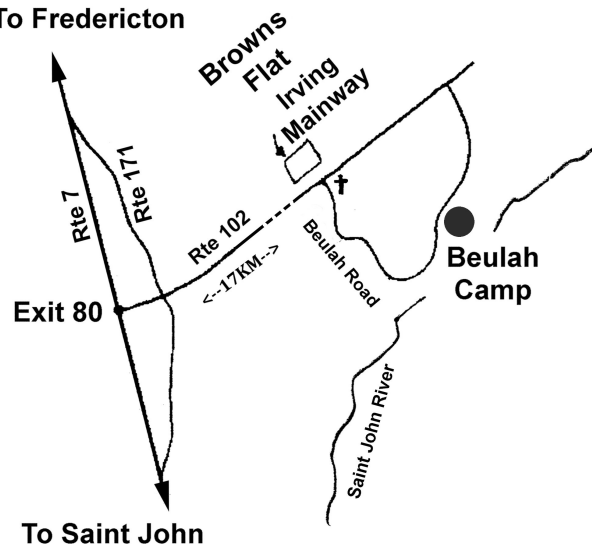
