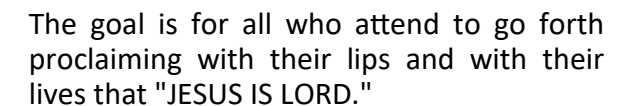

Prayer Vigil

An around the clock prayer vigil is maintained throughout the Ashram. Everyone is encouraged, but not required, to participate.

Period of Silence

From 11 PM until morning devotions, we strive to maintain a time of silence in order that God may speak to us. This is a discipline of meditation.

Healing Service

Saturday evening we will be given the opportunity to join in prayer specifically for total healing: body, mind, and spirit.

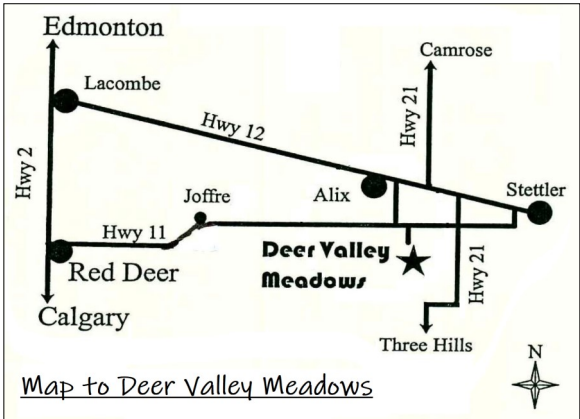
