The Christian Ashram is <u>interdenominational</u> and <u>interracial</u>. We endeavour to remove all barriers that separate Christians one from another. Not only barriers of class and position, but barriers of envy, resentment, grudges and prejudices are broken down. Often the family relationships are restored and loyalty to Christ and the Church renewed.

Period of Silence


From 11 PM until morning devotions, we strive to maintain a time of silence in order that God may speak to us. This is a discipline of meditation.


